

# CRESTED BUTTE – EASY TO GET TO with LODGING CHOICES and DEALS

CRESTED BUTTE, CO – The Crested Butte area is accessed by the airport in the nearby town of Gunnison (GUC). Guests have daily flight choices and transportation to your lodging is easily accomplished. The lodging varies from chain hotels in Gunnison which is a 45-minute ride away, to riverside cabins in Almont - a 20 minute ride from the ski area, to family run B & B's and fine condos in the town and mountain resort.

Many people who live in the Gunnison Valley first came for the winters with lots of snow and the excellent skiing. With over 300 inches of snow per year, Crested Butte Mountain Resort offers a great variety of uncrowded terrain. Here is a sample of favorite lodging properties in the Gunnison-Crested Butte area.

### THREE RIVERS RESORT

In Almont, Colo., Three Rivers Resort is a great place to stay. The resort is located in

the historic town of Almont, a short 20-minute drive to Crested Butte. The ski area bus stop is only steps away from the resort.

The name Three Rivers Resort refers to its location. The resort sits on the Taylor River, which merges with the East River to form the Gunnison River. It is a scenic short walk away. Blue skies, high mountains and crystal-clear trout-filled waters make the location the ideal getaway. The Gunnison National Forest is literally in its backyard.

The types of accommodations range from hotel-style rooms and one- or two-bedroom cabins, to three- or 4-bedroom houses. The cabins have kitchens, and some have hot tubs and fireplaces. Although the oldest

cabins date back to the late 1800s, they have been remodeled recently and are modern and very comfortable.
