Also voted Top 5 in the East for Snow, Service and Family Programs, Bretton Woods can be as calm on the corduroy or as gritty in the glades as you like.

A full service ski school, rental and demo shop, along with great deals like Two-for-One Wednesdays (non-holiday) and the free Learning Center Quad (midweek/non-holiday) make Bretton Woods the perfect choice for skiers and riders of all ages and abilities.

GUIDED ALPINE AND NORDIC SKI TOURS

Adventurous skiers can look forward to the best trails and glades to suit their abilities and interests, with preferred lift line access along the way. Tours are available for alpine and Nordic skiers, who are assured to get the most out of the day by learning skills on the slopes and in the backcountry alike. Tours cost \$35 per person. Rental equipment is available. Guests must have a valid lift ticket or trail pass.

GUIDED NORDIC DOWNHILL TOUR

Take full advantage of one of New Hampshire's unique trails, Mountain Road. Learn skills that will help you feel more comfortable on the downhill and in the backcountry while on your Nordic skis. Tours cost \$35 per person, including a one-way lift ticket. Rental equipment is available. Guests must have a valid trail pass.

GUIDED SNOWSHOE EXPEDITIONS

Explore a nearby mountain, and experience the wonders of the winter forest. Experience the best terrain, stunning scenery and get an excellent workout en route to higher summits. Tours cost \$55 per person, including rentals.

CUSTOM BACKCOUNTRY ADVENTURES

Take your backcountry experience where it has never been before with a customized adventure guided by Steve Nichipor. He brings all his expertise along for cold weather ascents of Mount Washington, backcountry skiing in Tuckerman Ravine and ice climbing at Frankenstein Cliff. The possibilities are limitless. Tours cost \$275 per person per day for private tours, \$185 per person per day for semi-private tours. Rental equipment is available.

In addition to these new guided programs, the Bretton Woods Canopy Tour continues to offer an exciting and unique winter experience through the trees and above the snow-covered slopes. With nine zip lines, two sky bridges and three rappel stations, nature lovers and thrill-seekers alike will descend over 1,000 feet into the Bretton Woods base area, ending with the Williaw dual racing zip which may be enjoyed as a thrill ride on its own. The popular Zip and Ski combo ticket is just \$99 this winter, including the Canopy Tour and a full day of skiing at Bretton Woods.
