The bar's innovative cocktails are even more delicious when paired with vocals and acoustic guitar music performed by long-time Hyatt favorite Luke Stevenson. For a unique treat, enjoy your handcrafted martini beside the blazing fire of Lone Eagle's outdoor fire pits, right next to the resort's private beach.

Sensational seafood makes headlines (it is flown in daily) along with plump wild Yellowfoot Chanterelles mushrooms, briny northwestern oysters, and richly flavored game meats. Indulge in Butter-Poached Sea Bass, Braised Leeks, Pesto Polenta, and Tomato Caper Salsa or Rack of Colorado Lamb with Ratatouille, Chickpea Fries and Tomato Garlic Lamb Jus.

### CAMP HYATT

### ENVIRONMENTAL CODE OF THE SLOPES

#### WHAT SKIERS and RESORT GUESTS CAN DO TO HELP

Follow the *Leave No Trace™*  
Principles of outdoor ethics:

- **Plan ahead and prepare:**  
Know the regulations and special concerns of the area you will visit, prepare for winter weather, and consider off-peak visits when scheduling your trip.
- **Dispose of waste properly:**  
Recycle your glass, plastics, aluminum and paper at resorts. Reuse trail maps on your next visit or recycle them. Never throw trash, cigarette butts or other items from the lifts.
- **Respect wildlife:**  
Observe trail closures, seasonal closures, and ski area boundaries. These closures are in place not only for your safety, but the well being of plants and animals located in sensitive areas. In summer, stick to designated trails when hiking and biking to avoid disturbances to vegetation and wildlife.
- **Be considerate:**  
Respect other guests, protect the quality of their experience; let nature's sounds prevail. Carpool with friends and family or use transit to avoid traffic when travelling to and within the ski area. Turn off the lights when leaving your room and reuse bath towels and linens to help conserve energy.
