NEW SAFETY TECHNOLOGY FOR KIDS

New this winter, Homewood Mountain Resort will offer the Magnestick® chairlift safety system, the newest introduction to chair ride safety for kids. Magnestick® includes an electromagnetic seatback and corresponding magnetic vest worn by children riding a chairlift.

Chairlift seatbacks are equipped with a magnet, and the back of a child’s Magnestick® vest is equipped with a flat, metal disc that holds them securely in place for the duration of the lift ride.

When a child reaches the chairlift deboarding platform, the Magnestick® vest is deactivated, allowing for a seamless release from the seatback. Magnestick® has been installed on Homewood Mountain Resort’s Quail chairlift, adjacent to Homewood’s Snow Rangers Academy, the children’s center.
