

MAMMOTH LODGING FOCUSES on WINTER with GREAT OFFERS and CONVENIENCE

MAMMOTH LAKES, CA – Bowlers, golfers and foodies alike will all have a ball at the Mammoth Rock 'n Bowl in Mammoth Lakes, Calif. This state-of-the-art bowling and indoor recreation center combines a bowling alley, a full indoor golf center and an upscale restaurant as well casual dining at the bowling lanes and lounge. Mammoth Mountain Ski Area is a world-class ski resort, offering 3,500 acres of skiable terrain. The Alpenhof Lodge

Settle in for an enjoyable stay at the Alpenhof Lodge. Their 58 recently renovated rooms, suites and cabins offer the perfect place to relax and unwind in Mammoth Lakes. Accommodations are comfortable and well appointed, with clean lines and an alpine atmosphere.

Thoughtful amenities include new bed linens, iPod docking alarm clocks, new lighting and photography by local photographer Vern Clevenger.

This warm, friendly lodge lets you stay connected with complimentary WiFi access in your room or relax in front of your flat-screen TV. Some of the rooms offer views of the mountains or the Village at Mammoth. Complimentary Continental breakfast is included along with other amenities.

Alpenhof Lodge is home to Petras Bistro and Wine Bar, which features fine food and offers more than 30 wines by the glass. This is a gem of a restaurant. They are open for dinner Tuesday through Sunday.

The property also boasts one of the best bars in town, The Clocktower Cellar. Open seven nights a week, they feature 26 awesome beers on tap and numerous bottled beers. The bar also features 130 whiskies and eclectic food that includes burgers and the house specialty "tachos" - nachos made with tater tots instead of chips.

Holiday Haus Motel and Hostel

Holiday Haus underwent a major renovation in the summer of 2011. Guests have witnessed an impressive transformation in which their 15 modest rooms were renovated into lovely historical-interest spaces. Each room has brand new linens, down comforters and pillows, re-done flooring and new furniture. Most rooms are equipped with gas fireplaces, mini-fridges and microwaves. An outdoor hot tub with a completely re-built and re-painted deck is a nice place to relax.

As part of Mammoth's rich history in a key spot on Mammoth's Main St. for over 50 years, this landmark motel is still priced for budget-conscious travelers, but now offers an updated take on this true classic.

The major renovation debuted a few years ago to rave reviews. In addition to updated furniture, bedding, flooring and fixtures, all Holiday Haus motel rooms are theme decorated with archival photos and posters from the old days of Mammoth. The owners worked with the Curator of the Hayden Cabin for the Southern Mono Historical Society, Mark Davis, to give each room a unique personality.

This winter, the "Casitas" at Holiday Haus are perfect for a family trip. They have one king bed, pull out couch and full kitchen. The Casitas were opened for the 2015-16 season and provide great space for family and friends at reasonable prices.

Their new double-king chalet is the ultimate lodging facility with two king bedrooms, fold out couch in the living room and master bedroom. It also has two baths, a dining room and full kitchen.

For one of the most impressive hostel-type accommodation you will find in a ski town, check out their brand new European style hotel and modern hostel. In addition to the bedrooms, it has a large communal kitchen, TV lounge and reading area.

The property is located about a five-minute walk from the Village at Mammoth, which is the access point for the Village Gondola. The free bus service is conveniently located steps away on Main Street.

New for winter 2016-17 was the completely repaved parking lot and regraded driveway. Guests will find this very helpful on the snowy winter Mammoth Lakes mornings, getting out ahead of the plows.
