## SCHWEITZER'S IMPROVEMENTS CONTINUE IN EXCESS OF \$6 MILLION

SANDPOINT, ID - Schweitzer Mountain Resort was busy this past summer working on improving the overall guest experience through various projects and capital invest-ments in equipment and infrastructure.

In July 2015, Schweitzer Mountain Resort started construction of a new summit lodge. The 13,000-square-foot, three-story summit lodge will offer an amazing venue for onmountain dining and relaxation with a full service restaurant, bar, cafeteria, lodging accommodations, space for group functions and a new home for ski patrol dispatch. Completion is anticipated for the fall of 2016.

This summer, Schweitzer invested over \$80,000 with Frontier Communications for upgrades to the internet supply infrastructure. The resort has switched from copper to fiber optic lines and has installed new antennas that will dramatically increase bandwidth resort-wide. This upgrade to the wireless and hardwire services will offer 20 times more capacity than what was previously available to guests and will offer options to add more bandwidth as demand grows.

The Real Estate market is continuing to grow at Schweitzer. Partners Copper Basin Construction and Tom-linson Sotheby's have been busy bringing the next phases of MountainSide to life, with 10 units delivered, 3 pre-sold units ready for Christmas 2016, several spec homes under construction and additional planned releases and building lots

Over 80 Is Free Plus More Grooming and Ski School

Schweitzer is pleased to announce that skiers and riders over the age of 80 are eligible for free lift tickets this winter.

In keeping with Schweitzer's tradition of impeccable grooming, the resort purchased an additional Prinoth BR350 grooming machine and a Nordic trail groomer for this winter.

The Snowsports School developed two additions to their ne Showsports School developed two additions to their list of ski and snowboard lessons options. Through them, a new Winter Break Ski Camp is offered during Dec. 21-24 and/or Dec. 28-31 this winter. The camp is great for 5 to 12 year olds who will participate in a four-day ski camp running from 9:30am to 3pm each day. The price for the camp is \$175 per session (does not include lift passes), and upgrades to the Mtn Xplorers and Funatics programs are possible.

Schweitzer Snowsports School is also offering an apprentice instructors program for skiers and riders 13 to 17 years old this winter. The program will last four weeks, including shadow days with the instructor team. Participants will get an unlimited junior season pass as part of the program.

The resort has also replaced the entire fleet of adult Alpine rental equipment with brand new Rossignol Experience skis.

Schweitzer, through its utility division the Mountain Utility Company, spent approximately \$65,000 in capital and maintenance dollars on the wastewater treatment system that serves 883 residential users in the Schweitzer mountain community. This included ongoing upgrades to the wastewater irrigation system, currently 65 active forested acres out of 145 permitted acres, as well as repairs to the collection network.

On the mountain, the trail crew completed brush cutting in the Outback Bowl with work being done on G3, Lakeside Chutes run-out, lower Snow Ghost, and Quicksilver.
